



A notice to our valued customers regarding the Coronavirus/COVID-19 outbreak

We at India's Restaurant are grateful to our valued customers who have supported us for the past 30 years. We are aware of the current outbreak of the Coronavirus/COVID-19 here in Colorado. Our restaurant follows all national and Denver food health and safety regulations regularly, and we pride ourselves on cleanliness. In addition to our regular daily cleaning procedures, we have increased the frequency of cleaning and disinfecting of high-contact surfaces in the dining room and in the kitchen.

A summary of the steps we are taking is listed below:

- 1. Increased frequency of cleaning/disinfecting on high-contact surfaces:** All door handles, including those for the restrooms and front doors are cleaned multiple times per hour. We have also increased the frequency of cleaning and disinfecting of chairs, booths, and other high-contact surfaces.
- 2. Increased frequency of handwashing and glove use among staff:** Our staff at India's has always regularly washed their hands during their shifts. With the current outbreak, we have instructed our staff to increase their frequency of hand-washing. In addition, we have increased glove and mask use among dining room staff. **At that this time, we politely ask you to not shake our staff's hands and instead use the traditional Indian greeting of Namaste.**
- 3. Additional sanitization of food-contact surfaces in the kitchen and increased vigilance among kitchen staff:** We have increased the cleaning/sanitization of food-contact surfaces in the kitchen. Furthermore, we have instructed kitchen staff to maintain and increase regular handwashing and glove use.
